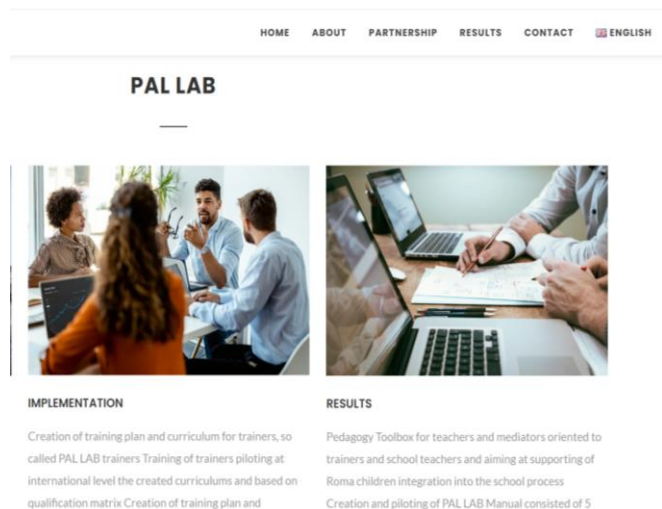
Continuing the Journey of Innovation and Inclusion
