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Report on Multiplier Event Greece

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Logistics of the Multiplier Event

On September 24th, 2024, in Thessaloniki, Greece, AeliaPath proudly hosted a significant Multiplier Event as part of the PAL Lab Erasmus+ Project. This event was held online and focused on fostering intercultural education and supporting inclusive practices for Roma children and youth. AeliaPath extended invitations to educators, mentors, Roma rights advocates, and specialists, gathering a group of dedicated professionals interested in applying the project's methodologies and resources in their contexts.

Event Highlights and Feedback

The event commenced with welcoming remarks and participant registration. As participants signed in, the team introduced the PAL Lab Erasmus+ Project, sharing its mission to support teachers, mediators, and specialists working with Roma communities. Attendees were then guided through the project's key achievements, such as the development of the Competence Matrix for educators and mediators, the Pedagogical Toolkit for trainers, and the PAL Lab e-learning platform. The team emphasized the value of these tools in promoting intercultural understanding and combating early school leaving.

The PAL Lab platform demonstration highlighted the e-learning modules available, encouraging participants to register and explore its resources. Feedback was overwhelmingly positive, with participants praising the project's comprehensive approach and practical applications. Discussions focused on the implementation of the Training Modules and the adaptability of the platform for diverse educational settings.
