## Logistics of the PalLabs Event

The PalLab event occurred online from Thessaloniki, Greece, on Monday, September 23, 2024, gathering 20 registered participants. The diverse group included teachers and educators, representatives from educational and counseling institutions, and academic administrators.

The event commenced with a presentation covering the PalLab Project's objectives, target audiences, and key outcomes achieved so far. All participants attended via the Google Meet platform, where they received an in-depth demonstration of the PalLab e-learning platform.

## Feedback from the PalLabs Event

The event began with introductions and a welcome to the participants. After presenting the agenda, the PalLab project, including its goals and the primary results achieved, was reviewed. Discussions followed on how these results could be utilized and integrated into local educational initiatives.

Participants were then guided through the platform registration process, and a practical demonstration addressed key features and usability aspects. Feedback gathered from attendees included the following insights:

- Training Content: Participants found the platform's training content to be comprehensive and valuable. Additionally, the presentations and external resources provided were appreciated as helpful tools for offline reference.
- Technical Aspects: Registration on both the platform and the courses proceeded smoothly, with no technical difficulties and minimal information requirements.
- User-Friendly Design: The user interface was rated highly for its simplicity and ease of use.
- Quiz Experience: Some participants noted challenges with the automatic start and timing of the quiz. Despite this, they appreciated the quiz's structure, acknowledging that while 25 questions require time, they found the quiz to be engaging and were motivated to complete it.

Overall, the event was productive and insightful, and the feedback collected will be instrumental in enhancing the PalLab platform's user experience.
