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Logistics of the PalLabs Event

MUSEV held the PalLabs events online on Monday 23 September 2024. A form was created to identify potential participants and 42 people registered to this form. The participants were educators with different backgrounds, educational administrators, representatives of educational institutions providing guidance and counselling services, volunteers working with disadvantaged groups.

The event started with a brief presentation of the aims, objectives, target group and results of the PalLab project. In the event, which was attended by approximately 40 people via Zoom platform, no serious technical problems were experienced and detailed examinations of the PalLab e-learning platform were carried out.

Feedback from the PalLabs Event

The online PalLabs event started with a welcome and short introduction of participants. After sharing the brief introduction of the speakers, agenda and the MUSEV Foundation, the PalLab project and its aims were presented and we analysed the results of the project and discussed how the project results can be useful and integrated at local level.

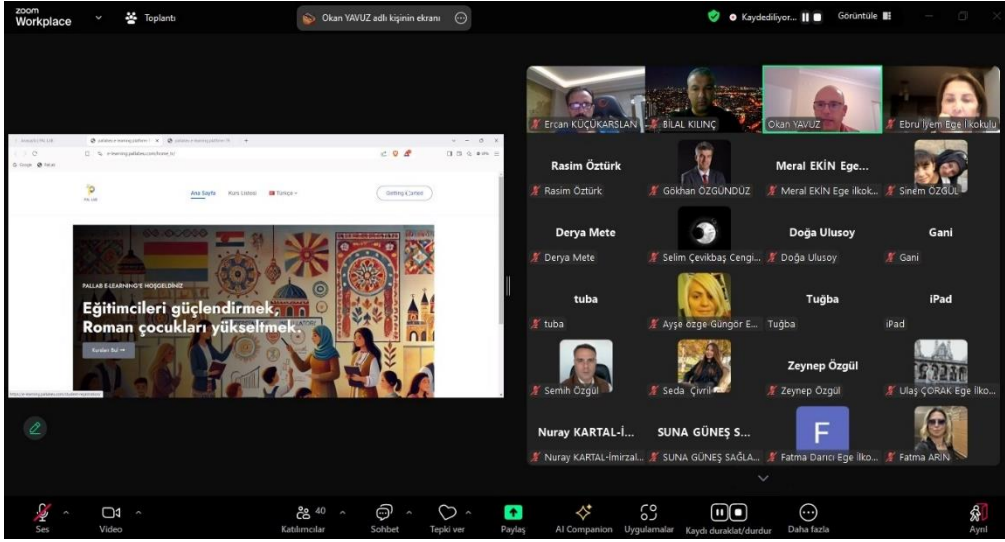
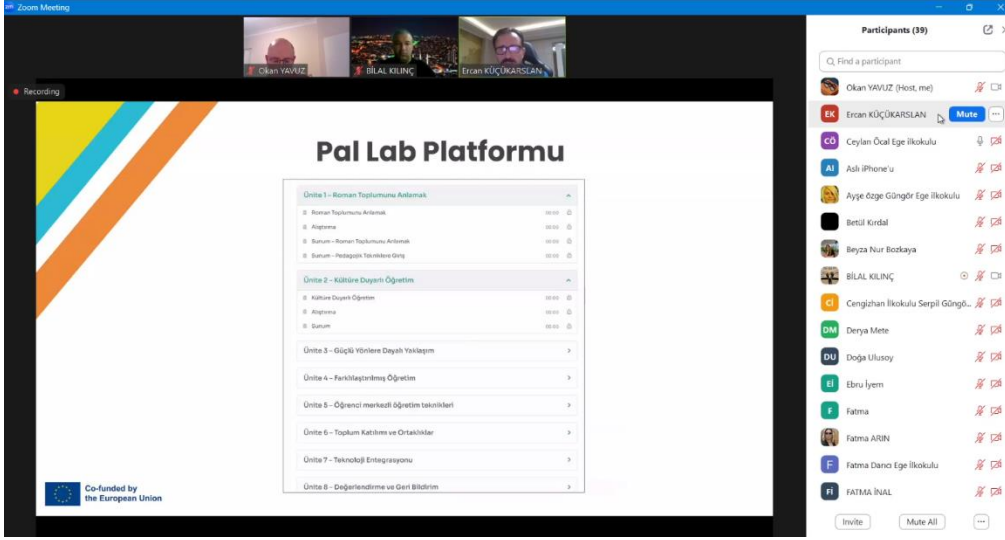
After the registration process of the platform and the basic issues to be followed were practically demonstrated, the platform was analysed in detail.

The general feedback from the participants can be summarised as follows:

- The platform is user-friendly with its user interface and simple design
- No technical difficulties were experienced during registration to both the platform and the courses and this process completed with minimal information
- The training content of the platform was considered as very useful and detailed. The shared presentations and external resources will also be useful offline.
- There was some confusion about the completion and progress of the courses. Although it was considered as a technical glitch, it did not have a negative impact on the progress.
- The automatic start of the quiz and the amount of time was evaluated negatively by some participants.
- Although the quiz questions were found to be of high quality and inclusive, it was commented that 25 questions were too many.
